

Rule 73.1 CONSENT TO TRIAL AND DISPOSITION OF CIVIL CASE BEFORE
MAGISTRATE JUDGES

(a) Consent.

Upon written consent of the parties, the Magistrate Judge located in Cheyenne, Wyoming, or such other Magistrate Judge as may be designated by the District Judge, may conduct any or all proceedings in any civil case which is filed in this Court [28 U.S.C. § 636]. (b) Automatic Referral.

A District Judge may automatically refer to the full-time Magistrate Judge civil cases for disposition, including the entry of final judgment in the case. The parties to a case which has been automatically referred to the full-time Magistrate Judge shall advise the District Judge in writing, within five (5) days after notification of referral, of their consent or objection to the jurisdiction of the full-time Magistrate Judge.
