**GENERAL ORDER LIFTING STAY FOLLOWING RESUMPTION OF
APPROPRIATIONS**

This matter comes before the Court *sua sponte* upon receiving notice from the United States Attorney for the District of Wyoming that the lapse in appropriations to the Department of Justice has ended. Therefore, IT IS HEREBY:

ORDERED that the General Order (2018-03) imposing a stay on all civil cases within the District of Wyoming in which the United States or an agency, corporation, officer or employee (deemed or otherwise) of the United States is hereby lifted. It is further

ORDERED that any filing deadlines stayed by the General Order shall resume effective today, January 28, 2019.
