Definitions:

<b>Ordinary</b>	A transcript to be delivered within thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of an order.
<b>14 Day</b>	A transcript to be delivered within fourteen (14) calendar days after receipt of an order.
<b>Expedited</b>	A transcript to be delivered within seven (7) calendar days after receipt of an order.
<b>Daily</b>	A transcript to be delivered following adjournment and prior to the normal opening hour of the court on the following morning whether or not it is an actual court day.
<b>Hourly</b>	A transcript ordered under unusual circumstances to be delivered within two (2) hours.
<b>Realtime Transcript</b>	A draft unedited transcript produced by a certified realtime reporter as a byproduct of realtime to be delivered electronically during proceedings or immediately following adjournment.
