RESTRICTIONS ON COURTHOUSE ENTRY DURING THE CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

The United States District Court for the District of Wyoming is closely monitoring the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic. Consistent with the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Interim Guidance for Businesses and Employers the Federal District Court for the District of Wyoming has implemented mitigation protocols to reduce potential community exposure and transmission of this virus.

Given the significant number of identified and projected cases of COVID-19 in the surrounding states, and the severity of the risk posed to the public should local widespread community transmission occur, it is hereby ORDERED, effective, Tuesday, March 17, 2020, that persons may not enter the District of Wyoming courthouse:

- 1. If they have traveled to, reside with, or have had close contact with someone who has been to any of these countries within the last 14 days:
 - Iran, China, South Korea, Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Slovakia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Monaco, San Marino, Vatican City, and
 - Any other country for which the CDC has issued a Level 3 travel health notice.
- 2. If they have been asked to self-quarantine by any physician, hospital, or healthcare

agency.

- 3. If they have been diagnosed with or have had close contact with anyone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19.
- 4. If they are experiencing signs of a fever, a cough, or shortness of breath.

If any of the above apply to you, **<u>DO NOT ENTER</u>** the courthouse. Instead, please contact the appropriate person and/or agency to discuss your situation:

The court will continue to monitor directives from the CDC, and local health departments and reevaluate our response to this virus as needed. These restrictions will remain in effect until it is determined otherwise.
