**ORDER**

The Judicial Conference of the United States has approved a new 3-day transcript delivery category, defined as “a transcript to be delivered within three (3) calendar days after receipt of an order.” The Judicial Conference also approved language clarifying the definitions of daily, hourly, and realtime transcripts.

The District of Wyoming hereby adopts the new transcript delivery category as well as the clarifying definitions. A revised Schedule of Maximum Rates for all categories of transcript is attached and will also be posted on the District of Wyoming’s website at [www.wyd.uscourts.gov](http://www.wyd.uscourts.gov).

## MAXIMUM TRANSCRIPT RATES

	Original	First Copy to Each Party	Each Additional Copy to the Same Party
<b>Ordinary Transcript (30 day)</b> A transcript to be delivered within thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$3.65	\$ .90	\$ .60
<b>14-Day Transcript</b> A transcript to be delivered within fourteen (14) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$4.25	\$ .90	\$ .60
<b>Expedited Transcript (7 day)</b> A transcript to be delivered within seven (7) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$4.85	\$ .90	\$ .60
<b>3-Day Transcript</b> A transcript to be delivered within three (3) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$5.45	\$1.05	\$ .75
<b>Daily Transcript</b> A transcript to be delivered on the calendar day following receipt of the order (regardless of whether that calendar day is a weekend or holiday), prior to the normal opening hour of the clerk's office.	\$6.05	\$1.20	\$ .90
<b>Hourly Transcript</b> A transcript of proceedings to be delivered within two (2) hours from receipt of the order.	\$7.25	\$1.20	\$ .90
<b>Realtime Transcript</b> A draft unedited transcript produced by a certified realtime reporter as a byproduct of realtime to be delivered electronically during proceedings or immediately following receipt of the order.	One feed, <sup>1</sup> \$3.05 per page; two-to-four feeds, \$2.10 per page; five or more feeds, \$1.50 per page.		

<sup>1</sup>A realtime "feed" is the electronic data flow from the court reporter to the computer of each person or party ordering and receiving the realtime transcription in the courtroom.
