

Pursuant to the United States Judicial Conference Policy on Privacy and Public Access to Electronic Criminal Case Files.

Effective November 1, 2004

- ♦ The public will be allowed access to criminal court filings from remote access through PACER.
- ♦ Redaction requirements for filers, whether the document is filed electronically or in paper, are as follows:
 - Social Security numbers to the last four digits
 - financial account numbers to the last four digits
 - names of minor children to the initials
 - dates of birth to the year
 - home addresses to city and state
- **♦** Documents for which NO public access should be provided.
 - unexecuted warrants
 - presentence reports
 - supervised violation reports
 - statement of reasons

 - financial affidavits submitted seeking court appointed counsel
 - ex parte requests for expert or investigative services at court expense
 - sealed documents
- ♦ The responsibility for redaction rests with counsel and the parties, not with the Clerk of Court.
